1) What should be added to 3485 to get 7694 ?

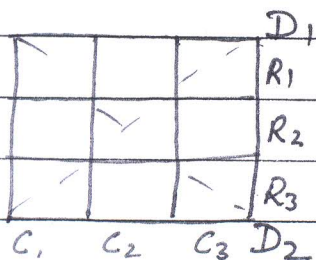
★ Check whether to add or subtract in each of these problems. Do these problems with complete statement.

5) Fill in the boxes :

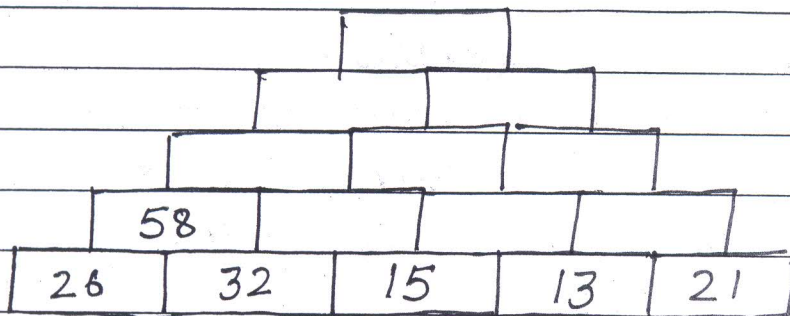
